INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

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The Cybertech sectional matrix system, indicated for Class II restorations, is composed of preformed sectional matrices available in 3 sizes, including rings for its attachment and silicone tips. The sectional matrix provides an easier reconstruction of contact points, maintains the tooth's natural anatomy and is equipped with silicone tips that provide a better adaptation. **Use:** Isolate the operative field with a rubber dam or other suitable isolation technique. Select the appropriate matrix size for the cavity that is to be restored. Install the matrix in the proximal face that is to be restored. Make sure that the product is fully seated in the pliers. Avoid leaving the pliers one face at a time. Install the wedge. Install the ring. In concluding the restoration, first remove the ring, then the wedge and finally the matrix. To obtain consistent contact points it is

recommended to promote a previous separation of the adjacent tooth, during the initial patient preparation, by inserting a wedge and/or placing the ring.

**Matrix Shapes:** Available in small, medium and large sizes. **Warnings, precautions and restrictions:** Professional use only. The matrices are of single use. Their reuse can cause cross-contamination. When there is any proven allergy to any of its components, the product must not be used. Excessive expansion with the pliers can result in poor staple placement and loss of anatomical form. **Use:** Isolate the operative field with a rubber dam or other suitable isolation technique. Select the appropriate matrix size for the cavity that is to be restored. Install the matrix in the proximal face that is to be restored. Make sure that the product is fully seated in the pliers. Avoid leaving the pliers one face at a time. Install the wedge. Install the ring. In concluding the restoration, first remove the ring, then the wedge and finally the matrix.
